*The **Trademark Case Files Dataset** contains detailed information on 12.1 million trademark applications filed with or registrations issued by the USPTO between January 1870 and February 2023.*

## 03. The Norwegian and Belgian national patent collections and the F-term & FI classifications are now available in PATENTSCOPE

**PATENTSCOPE NOW PROVIDES ACCESS 78 NATIONAL AND REGIONAL COLLECTIONS**

*The national patent collections of Norway and Belgium are now available in WIPO's global patent search system PATENTSCOPE. The Norwegian collection includes over 225,000 patent documents while the national patent collection of Belgium over 326,500 patent documents.*

*With the inclusion of these two national collections, PATENTSCOPE now provides access to a total of 78 national and regional collections. In addition to the aforementioned collections, the Japanese classifications FI and F-terms for the national Japanese collection were also added. ## 04. Eurasian Patent Organization expands cooperation with WIPO

**NEW AREAS ADDED, INDUSTRIAL DESIGN PROTE'N, IMPLEMENT'N OF ALTERN'VE DISPUTE RESOL'N & DEVEL'T OF EDUCA'L PROJECTS**

*The Sixty-Fourth Series of Meetings of the Assemblies of the Member States of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO), one of the key events for IP offices, officially opened today. President of the Eurasian Patent Office (EAPO) Grigory Ivliev and Director General of WIPO Daren Tang held a meeting on the margins of the Assemblies. The parties discussed the implementation of a joint project for technoparks on rights management, capacity building projects, and priorities of the EAPO Development Program up to 2028. Significant attention was paid to the legal aspects of the accession of the Eurasian Patent Organization to the Hague System for the International Registration of Industrial Designs.*

## 05. Mobile Applications for TIPO's TWCA Digital Certificates are Now Available

TIPO commissioned TAIWAN-CA (TWCA) to issue mobile certificates to optimize our digital application services and enhance compatibility with mobile devices. These certificates will support services such as online trademark applications, My Dashboard, My Cases, and other related services that require mobile certificate signing and identity verification. Visit TWCA's certificate application site and fill out the form to apply for mobile digital certificates. You will be required to submit documentation and send the application either directly to TWCA's Taipei office or to TIPO offices in Hsinchu, Taichung, Tainan, and Kaohsiung.....[Read more](#)

## 06. PPH pilot program between the Japan Patent Office (JPO) and the National Institute of Industrial Property of France (INPI)

**PCT APPLICATION  
CANNOT DIRECTLY  
ENTER THE NATIONAL  
PHASE AT THE INPI**

To increase the number of eligible PPH applications, the JPO and the INPI have agreed to add PPH MOTTAINAI and PCT-PPH in the program and start accepting requests on 1 July 2023. Please note that a PCT application cannot directly enter the national phase at the INPI. For certain types of applications eligible for PCT-PPH at the INPI based on a PCT international work product by the JPO, please refer to Figures A to C in ANNEX II to the Guidelines for filing with the INPI available on the following page.
